

What is the Cylance Security Professional (CSP) Exam?

The CSP exam tests your knowledge of the core features and functions of the Cylance Prevention Platform™. The CSP exam is web-based and consists of 75 multiple-choice questions. You are given two hours to complete the exam and can retake it as many times as necessary to earn a passing score of 80%.

Does the Cylance Security Professional (CSP) credential expire?

The CSP exam credential expires after one year. At that time, you will need to take the exam again to be recertified.

Is there a cost for taking the Cylance Security Professional (CSP) exam?

The CSP exam is free of charge. You can access the exam once you are registered and log in to the Cylance Learning Center.

How should I prepare for taking the Cylance Security Professional (CSP) exam?

How do I take the Cylance Security Professional (CSP) exam?

The CSP exam is accessed via the Cylance Learning Center. Log in to the Learning Center and select the “ACCREDITATION: CYLANCE SECURITY PROFESSIONAL (CSP) Exam” in the Course Library. You can then click on the icon and “Start this Course” to begin the exam.

How long do I have to complete the Cylance Security Professional (CSP) exam?

The exam is timed. You will have two hours to complete the exam. If you select exit to leave the exam before completing, the exam timer will pause. When you return, select the course and click “Continue this course”. The timer will start again.

Can I review my answers before submitting them for scoring?

Yes. Once you have answered the questions, a review page will allow you to review and change your answers. If you want to change an answer, click “Change this answer” and the question will pop up for you to update your answer. Once you have reviewed all your answers and you are ready to submit them, click “Complete” to get your score.

What is the required passing score on the Cylance Security Professional (CSP) exam?

The CSP exam requires an 80% score or better to pass. You can retake the exam as many times as necessary to earn a passing score.

How many questions are on the Cylance Security Professional (CSP) exam?

Each CSP exam consists of 75 questions which are randomly selected from a larger pool of questions.

How do I retake the Cylance Security Professional (CSP) exam?

When you are ready to retake the exam, log in to the Cylance Learning Center. Select the “ACCREDITATION: CYLANCE SECURITY PROFESSIONAL (CSP) Exam” and click “Continue this Course”

5. A printable PDF of the certificate of accreditation will download to your system
